## Safety and Health On-Site

**Consultation:** SCATS offers on-site consultation services designed to help employers recognize and control potential safety and health hazards at their workplaces, improve their safety and health program, assist in training employees, and possibly qualify for an exemption from Nevada OSHA general schedule enforcement inspections. These high quality safety and health consultation services focus on preventing injuries and illnesses.

On-site consultation services are confidential and provided free of charge at the request of employers. The employer may request a full service visit or limit their request to a specific problem. Consultation services are completely separate from the Nevada OSHA inspection effort and are performed by our staff of highly qualified safety and health professionals.

The consultation visit includes an opening conference, discussion of employer obligations, review of recordkeeping and required programs, survey of the operation, evaluation of hazardous safety and health conditions, review of findings at the closing conference, and written report of findings. Consultants issue no citations or penalties for non-compliance, but employers must agree to correct all identified imminent danger and serious hazards in a timely manner and must report that corrective action has been taken.

A list of identified hazards also must be posted where all affected employees can read and review it.
