

# Safe Partner Award

**Safe Partner Award:** The Safe Partner Award is designed to increase both employer and employee knowledge of the value of safety in the workplace. Recognition is granted for utilizing full service consultation services as well as completing significant SCATS formal training. Recipients are publicly recognized for having achieved the award through publicity and recognition activities of the program.

**Safe Partner Criteria:** Employers must meet one of 6 criteria to qualify for the Safe Partner Award. The criteria concepts are broad and cover the following:

- Concept 1; Comprehensive
- Concept 2; Construction
- Concept 3; General Industry
- Concept 4; Association
- Concept 5; Specialty Type A
- Concept 6; Specialty Type B

**Activities Required:** A combination of several activities are required in order to receive the Safe Partner Award. The extent of the activities that must be completed to achieve the award varies depending upon which of the criteria concepts an employer wishes to follow to qualify. Among those activities are the following:

- Voluntarily request SCATS conduct a comprehensive Consultation survey(s)
- Management participates in the Consultation survey(s)

- Management responds timely to correcting hazards
- Management, supervisors, safety committee, and staff attend appropriate training classes
- Report the results of hazards and controls of the surveys to other members of the association
- Publish the SCATS training schedule in their association newsletter
- Request SCATS attend and participate in quarterly meetings
- Develop a new safety position
- Communicate to all company locations the changes recommended by SCATS
- Make changes in policies, procedures, and training to meet the requirements
- Implement the changes
